Narrative

On this date I was contacted by dispatch in reference to [redacted] calling numerous times and harassing dispatchers. This has been an ongoing problem and I have documented several of these events. See reports 14-17566, 14-15679, 14-17705, 14-17824, 14-17893 & 14-18022. [redacted] was warned previously not to call unless there was a legit police purpose (14-15679) and that if the harassment continued charges would be filed against him. Twelve phone calls made today were attached to this report. During one these phone calls, I again warned [redacted] not to call unless he had a legitimate business reason. After speaking to him he called back immediately. I went to [redacted] residence and spoke briefly to him through the front door and explained that charges were being filed against him. I also advised him each time he called without a legitimate business reason from this point on he would be charged each time.
