Man robs Panama City Wal-Mart pharmacy

An armed man made off with a small amount of prescription drugs Saturday from the Wal-Mart on 23rd Street, Panama City police said in a news release.

The man entered the pharmacy section of the store about 2 p.m., showed the handle of a gun and demanded certain prescription drugs, officials said. He then fled the store through the garden section with an undisclosed amount of drugs. No cash was taken in the incident, officials said. Police did not specify which drugs the suspect stole.

Police are looking for the suspect, described as a white male between 50 and 55 years old, with
